VSM Weekly Venues

Here at VSM, we focus on our weekly venues rather than special events so that we can walk steadily with students and live for Christ together. Our events take place in the VSM Student Center, featuring an affordable café, ping pong, pool, air hockey, & video games.

Sunday Mornings (Discipleship)

180 Worship Service @ 10:15am & 11:30am

This is a venue for middle school and high school students, revolving around discipleship, where students will experience worship music, hear Biblical teaching, and connect with small group leaders and peers their age to grow in relationships and in walking with Christ together.

Wednesday Nights (Outreach)

The Mix (Middle School) @ 7 – 8:15pm

This weekly event is high energy, revolves around outreach and community, and is designed as a safe place to bring unchurched friends to VSM. Doors open at 6:30pm, so come grab a snack at the café, or play pool or ping pong. Meets in the Student Center (Room #30).

The Mix (High School) @ 7 – 8:15pm

Our high school night is the encouragement that you need to get through the week strong! Pivotal relationships are built with adults and peers, and we play together and grow together through Bible-based teaching. This is an environment designed to bring your unchurched friends to VSM. Meets in PowerHouse (Room #27).

Short Term Bible Studies & Student Leadership

We seek to use high school students in servant leadership in many ways, whether it is in the worship band, tech, outreach team, or another area of our church. For high school students who are looking for more in-depth Bible study, there will be short-term opportunities offered, so watch for them on the calendar!
